The following three structures have been identified by the County as needing improvement:

Bridge W-7: Green Avenue over Debbie's Creek

Structure W-8: Fisk Avenue Culvert between Debbie's Creek and The Glimmer Glass:

Bridge W-9: Brielle Road Bridge over The Glimmer Glass

The project purpose, needs, and goals/objectives were developed by the project team and presented to various stakeholders and the general public in May 2016 for comment.

The project purpose, needs, and goals/objectives will serve as a basis for the development and assessment of alternatives. The project team has preliminarily identified the following alternatives for each structure which will be presented at the upcoming Public Information Centers:

Bridge W-7:

- 1 – No-Build
- 2 – Rehabilitation
- 3 – Replacement of Bridge

Structure W-8:

- 1 – No-Build
- 2 – Rehabilitation
- 3 – Elimination of the Culvert
- 4 – Replacement of Culvert

Structure W-9:

- 1 – No-Build
- 2 – Rehabilitation
(with 3 sub-alternatives)
- 3 – Parallel Bridge
(with 3 sub-alternatives)
- 4 – Replacement of Bridge
(with 4 sub-alternatives)
- 5 – Relocation of Bridge
(with 2 sub-alternatives)

We are seeking your input on the alternatives presented through your discussions with Project Team members. You'll have an opportunity to provide input before and after the brief presentation. You will also have the opportunity to comment within the 40 day post Public Information Center comment period (extended from typical 30 day period due to holiday season), until January 24, 2017.
